Does the Club provide homework help?

Does the Club provide snack?

Each Club provides a free and healthy snack every day afterschool and during the summer.



Is the Club open on non-school days?

Can my child sign themselves out of the Club and walk home?

The Club has an 'open door policy,' allowing students to sign themselves out with written permission from parents. This must be cleared with your respective Clubhouse Director ahead of time.

Your Child's Safety is our #1 Priority

Our organization is committed to the highest standards of safety and integrity and maintains a zero tolerance policy for behavior that harms a child. Our Clubhouses are designed and programmed to be physically and emotionally safe places for our children and teens under the guidance of caring, trained, and trustworthy staff.

Safety Cont...

- All staff, volunteers, and Board members undergo a strict background check prior to employment
- Every staff member completes CPR and first aid training and certification before working with youth
- The Club completes annual safety assessments, audits, and inspections
- Each Club has extensive and robust emergency protocols and procedures in place for unexpected situations
- Boys & Girls Clubs of St Helena and Calistoga facilitates a Safety Committee to continuously review all policies, procedures and guidelines.

Enrollment & Membership

Membership for the school year to all of our school-age sites is \$50. Scholarships are available and **no child will ever be turned away for financial reasons.** The Club accepts all applicants, and will not have a waitlist outside of any extenuating circumstances. Please inquire with your Club's Membership Director for more information.



Summer Memberships

Summer membership is \$60, and includes specialty camps and most field trips. To attend the Clubhouse before 10am, there is a \$5 drop-in fee, which can be bundled and paid for in one lump sum, calculated at the beginning of each summer.

Membership Requirements

- Child must have completed membership form on file (one day trial is allowed)
- Child must be 6 years old **OR** have completed their 1st day of kindergarten
- Students who have graduated high school are no longer eligible to attend

Electronic Devices

Personal tech device use (phones, watches, tablets, etc) are discouraged while at the Club, but can be used in designated areas for the communication to parent/guardian. The Club assumes no responsibility for lost, damaged, or stolen personal property.
